Aldermanic districts may not be finalized before mid-December. If you circulate nomination papers prior to the finalization of aldermanic districts, please double check the signatures to make sure that the signatures you gathered reside in the finalized aldermanic district before you submit your nomination papers. It is advisable that potential candidates collect more than the minimum number of signatures required to qualify for the ballot.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that if a primary is necessary, the primary will be held on Tuesday, Tuesday, February 21, 2012.
