EVERY PIECE OF LITTER HAS A PERSON'S FACE BEHIND IT (And it's not smiling!)

Saturday, September 10th, rain or shine, volunteers will flood to the Kenosha shoreline to participate in the **International Coastal Cleanup**.

This Great Lakes fall event is part of a worldwide program sponsored by The Ocean Conservancy. The purpose is to collect and document aquatic debris to determine its impact on the current marine pollution levels.

Volunteers pick up all litter within a designated stretch of beach and record data on provided forms as to the types of litter found. Forms are compiled by Keep Kenosha Beautiful and sent in to The Ocean Conservancy to be included in a marine debris study. An average cleanup takes one hour.

Event registration and distribution of garbage bags, gloves and data forms will take place at the Kenosha Harbor MarketPlace on 56th Street and 2nd Avenue, just south of the Kenosha Public Museum, from 9 AM to 2 PM.
