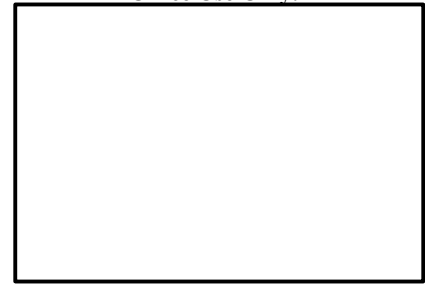

Note: All dumpsters must be clearly marked with flashers, barricades, or reflective tape. Barricades shall not extend further into the street than the width of the dumpster.

Permit is valid for eight days.

A Certificate of Insurance or Declaration of Insurance from an Insurance Agent must accompany this permit application. The Certification of Insurance must show the dates the policy is in effect and liability coverage provided for the following amounts: \$1,000,000 Personal, \$250,000 Occurrence, and \$50,000 Property

OR

For 1 or 2 family Dwellings: The property owner's current policy insurance card or Declaration Form from an insurance agent can be submitted indicating the following information:

- Name of property owner
- Address of property covered (shall match project address)
- Liability coverage in the amount of at least \$250,000
- Policy dates showing the policy is in effect when occupying the public right-of-way

No permit shall be issued to any person to use any portion of a street for the purposes aforesaid where the placing of such material or machinery upon the street or public ground will unreasonably interfere with public safety and convenience. Such permit shall be refused in every case where there is sufficient room for such material or machinery upon the same lot or premises, and such place is accessible from any street or alley [Code of General Ordinances 9.14].
