NAMING OF PARK AREAS

Kenosha's Board of Park Commissioners is seeking suggestions for a general name for the park located at 39th Avenue and 43rd Street, as well as names for each of the six ball diamonds.

Suggestions for the general park name should *not* be that of an individual; however, individual names for the ball diamonds will be considered. Kenosha residents and professional/civic organizations who would like to suggest names for the park and its diamonds must submit a letter containing their suggestions and a petition signed by at least 100 City of Kenosha residents. Individuals and organizations must submit their letter and petition by 4:30 PM on February 4, 2008 to: City of Kenosha Park Department, c/o Mary Durkee, 3617-65th Street, Kenosha WI 53142

The Board of Park Commissioners will consider all submissions in February 2008.
