2008 REFORESTATION PROGRAM

Beginning on Wednesday, January 2, 2008, the City of Kenosha Park Department is offering the citizens of Kenosha the opportunity to purchase street trees to be planted in the area between the sidewalk and curb. Orders are taken on a first-come, first-served basis until the end of January 2008. Trees are approximately 9 feet to 12 feet in height and there will be twelve varieties available. If your site meets the criteria for a new tree, your order will be processed, information and an order form will be mailed to you in late February. Payment must be received by April 13, 2008 to be eligible for this program. The trees will be planted during the growing season of 2008. While we will attempt to plant the tree of your choice, this is not always possible and a substitution may be necessary. The cost for each tree is \$100.00 which includes tax. The tree will be planted by City of Kenosha Park Department staff in 2008.

If you are interest in purchasing a tree, call the Park Department Field Office at 653-4080 beginning on Wednesday, January 2, 2008. Orders will be taken Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:15 am and 2:45 pm.
