

RESOLUTION NO. 136-06

**TO ESTABLISH STORMWATER UTILITY RATES WITHIN
THE CITY OF KENOSHA, WISCONSIN**

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2006, the Common Council adopted Ordinance No. 51-06, creating Chapter VIII of the Code of General Ordinances, entitled "Stormwater Utility", which established a Stormwater Utility within the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin; and,

WHEREAS, in the establishment of the aforementioned Stormwater Utility, rate classes have been instituted; and,

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee and Public Works Committee have recommended approval of the Stormwater Utility budget to the Common Council setting the proposed costs and anticipated revenues of the Stormwater Utility; and,

WHEREAS, rates shall be established to fund all components of the budget for the Stormwater Utility; and,

WHEREAS, such rates shall be composed of both a fixed portion per customer and a variable portion to be charged per EHU (Equivalent Hydraulic Unit); and,


WHEREAS, there are 32,021 customers and 77,000 total EHU's in the City of Kenosha.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, that effective **January 1, 2007**, a monthly rate shall be

\$1.02 per month, per customer, for the fixed portion, plus \$3.98 per EHU per month for the variable portion.
