KENOSHA – Kenosha residents are reminded that no banners, signs, decorations or obstructions are allowed in the public right-of-way – including political signs, business advertisements, festival announcements, etc. – per City ordinance. This includes placing signs on street lights and traffic signaling posts.

Exceptions require receiving permission in writing from the Director of Public Works.

People who are found in violation of Ordinance 5.045 may be subject to a fine of up to \$300 per day. When aware of a violation, the City will remove the signs or other obstructions from the public right-of-way. If you observe a violation of signs in the public right-of-way please call 262-653-4050.
