CLEOPATRA: LAST QUEEN OF EGYPT

 Friday, March 9 Depart: 9 am – Return: 5 pm
 Travel to the Milwaukee Public Museum to see "Cleopatra: The Search for the Last Queen of Egypt." Begin with an introductory presentation on the exhibit "Cleopatra's Universe" which explores the truths and mysteries of Egypt's legendary queen. Using the Planetarium's immersive full dome technology, experience the life and times of Cleopatra in dramatic fashion. See stunning re-creations of the Alexandria Library, Cleopatra's Palace, and the Pharos Lighthouse. Tour on your own the exhibit organized by National Geographic and Arts and Exhibitions International. The world of Cleopatra VII, lost to the sea and sand for nearly 2,000 years, is brought to life with nearly 150 artifacts from Cleopatra's time. Experience the present-day search for the elusive queen, which extends from the sands of Egypt to the depths of the Bay of Aboukir near Alexandria. A gourmet box lunch is included.

The exhibits include costumes, paintings, sculpture, photographs, and prints. Enjoy lunch at La Cebollita Mexican restaurant. In the afternoon you'll take a guided tour of Pilsen to see up to 30 murals both inside and outside of neighborhood buildings.
