KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT WE, the Principal and Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin, a municipal corporation as Obligee, in the full and just sum of_____Dollars and____/100 cents, lawful money of the United States, to the payment of which sum, well and truly to be made, the Principal and Surety bind themselves, their and each of their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. The Principal, Surety, and Obligee may be referred to as the parties.

{Obligee} THE CITY OF KENOSHA, WISCONSIN

The Principal has applied or is applying for a raze permit with the Obligee for the above project, which Permit is hereby incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as fully and to the same extent as if copied at length herein.

THE CONDITION OF THE OBLIGATION IS SUCH that if the Principal faithfully and completely performs the Permitted Work in accordance with the Code of General Ordinances for the City of Kenosha and all other Federal and State laws, rules and regulations, and any amendments thereto, pertaining to the Permitted Work, and promptly pays all persons supplying labor or material to the Principal for use in the prosecution of the Permitted Work under said Permit, then this obligation will be void; otherwise it will remain in full force and effect. For the avoidance of doubt, performing the Permitted Work in accordance with the Code of General Ordinances includes, but is not limited to, satisfying the requirements contained in Sections 9.17.A.3, 9.17.A.5, and 9.17.B, unless exempted pursuant to Sections 9.17.C or 9.17.D of said Code, in addition to satisfying the requirements of all other Ordinances.

Principal and Surety must, jointly and severally, save and hold harmless the Obligee from all losses, damages, costs and expenses which Obligee may sustain or for which Obligee may become liable arising from the issuance of the Permit and the performance of the Permitted Work. The aggregate liability for such will in no event exceed the amount set forth above.

BREACH: Upon the Principal's breach of either of the above obligations, the following will occur. The remedies that follow are not mutually exclusive and are listed in no particular order.

Subject to the Obligee's priority, all persons who have supplied labor or material directly to the Principal for use in the prosecution of the Permitted Work under the Permit have a direct right of action under this Bond against both the Principal and the Surety, jointly and severally.

Upon the Principal's breach, the City may immediately seek from the Principal an amount sufficient to satisfy the Principal's outstanding obligations, and may use any legal remedy to do so.

Upon notice of the Principal's breach, the Surety has the following options: promptly remedy the breach by causing the Permitted Work to be complete, or promptly pay to the Obligee an amount sufficient to satisfy the Principal's outstanding obligations. If the Surety fails to do either, the Surety is also in breach of this Performance and Payment Bond. In such circumstances, the Principal and Surety are jointly and severally liable to the Obligee for the remaining cost of completing the Permitted Work.

If the Permitted Work is on property owned by the Obligee, then the Obligee may perform the Permitted work or cause it to be performed by another person or entity of any kind. This is a right of the Obligee, not a mandatory duty. If the Obligee exercises this right, the Principal and Surety will be jointly and severally liable for the actual expenses the Obligee incurs.

EXECUTION. This Performance and Payment Bond is executed upon the signatures of all parties. The parties may sign this

Performance and Payment Bond with electronic signatures. This Performance and Payment Bond may be executed in counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one in the same instrument. This Performance and Payment Bond may also be transmitted among the parties electronically.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT. It is expressly understood and agreed between the parties hereto that this Performance and Payment Bond contains the entire understanding and agreement of the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter contained herein. There are no representations, warranties, covenants or undertakings other than those expressly set forth herein. It is specifically understood that this Performance and Payment Bond supersedes and cancels all prior negotiations, arrangements, discussions, correspondence (whether or not responded to) or agreements, contracts or understandings, whether oral or written, which may have taken place, or been in existence at any time between the parties.

LAW GOVERNING. The interpretation of this Agreement will be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin. The parties agree that any matter which may be brought or pursued in court must be brought and maintained only in the Circuit Court for Kenosha County, Wisconsin or United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin, and each party consents to said venue and the Court's personal jurisdiction over each party, provided all other procedures for the Court to acquire personal jurisdiction are followed (for the avoidance of doubt and by way of example only, this would include, but not be limited to, the proper service of a summons).

SEVERABILITY. If any of the provisions contained herein are declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Performance and Payment Bond will not be impacted thereby and will remain in full force and effect and will be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

AMEND IN WRITING. This Performance and Payment Bond may not be amended, changed, altered, modified or waived except by an express instrument in writing signed by the parties. It also may not be unilaterally canceled, or withdrawn from, by any of the parties.

GOOD FAITH. The parties each represent and covenant to the others that they will undertake the obligations set forth in this Performance and Payment Bond in the utmost good faith, and that each will deal fairly with the others and will cause all officers, officials, directors, agents, servants, and employees to embrace the provisions of this Performance and Payment Bond in good faith and to deal fairly with the other parties in all regards. The parties may and will rely on the provisions of this Performance and Payment Bond as agreed to by the other parties.

WAIVER. No extension of time, forbearance, neglect, or waiver on the part of the Obligee with respect to any one or more of the provisions of this Performance and Payment Bond will be construed as a waiver of any of the other provisions, or as an estoppel against them.

REPRESENTATION OF AUTHORITY. Each of the undersigned hereby represents and warrants that: (a) the signatories have all requisite power and authority to execute this Performance and Payment Bond on behalf of their respective parties, which includes holding a position within each party from which the signatory can legally bind it; (b) the execution and delivery of this Performance and Payment Bond by the undersigned, and the performance of its provisions thereby have been duly and validly authorized and approved by all requisite action required by law; (c) this Performance and Payment Bond constitutes the valid and binding agreement of the parties, enforceable against each of them in accordance with the provisions of the Performance and Payment Bond; and (d) if a seal must be affixed to this Performance and Payment Bond in order to bind any of the parties, any party so requiring a seal will affix it to this Performance and Payment Bond prior to that party signing below.

GUIDELINES FOR RAZING STRUCTURES

All Raze Permits shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. **Permit Term.** The razing of a building shall be completed within thirty (30) days after the date the permit was issued. The code official may at his/her discretion extend the permit term for cause. "Cause" shall mean the inability of the permittee to act due to circumstances beyond permittee's reasonable control upon the exercise of due diligence.
- 2. Inspection of Work. Work done under a raze permit is subject to inspection by the code official who shall have the authority to order corrective work. Failure to follow the orders of the code official, or to complete the raze in accordance with this code, shall give the code official authority to seek restitution from the required bond.
- 3. Foundation of Razed Building. Unless otherwise approved by the Code Official, whenever a Building has been razed, the foundation, if any, shall be removed and filled in with clean fill material approved by the City Engineer with the top two feet (2') of fill material being dirt or sand. No combustible material may be used for the fill material.
- **4. Driveway Approaches, Sidewalks and Slabs.** Remaining driveway approaches shall be removed and replaced with curb and gutter; damaged public sidewalks shall be replaced; and driveway aprons, remaining slabs and private sidewalks shall be removed from the site prior to final approval. See City of Kenosha, Public Works Department, for permits and construction standards.
- **5. Site Grading.** Whenever a building has been razed, the site shall be graded with a minimum of three inches (3") of topsoil, with seed and mulch or sod applied to cover the entire disturbed area.
- **6. Disposal of Debris.** The permit holder shall dispose of all building debris in a licensed landfill, except for salvaged materials. At any time, the license holder shall produce to the code official receipts and/or an itemized list of debris disposed of by dumping or salvage.
- 7. **Site Safety and Security.** The permit holder shall, during the razing process, maintain the razing site in a safe and secure condition, and the license holder shall promptly report any personal injury and property damage to the code official. The code official may require additional safety and security methods, including fencing and gating, as deemed necessary to protect the site and restrict access to the public.

Other Information:

Subsurface tanks or pits that are no longer used as a private sewage system shall be abandoned by complying with ALL of the following:

- Disconnecting all piping to tanks or pits
- > Sealing all disconnected piping in accordance with Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS), SPS 382.21 (2) (h)
- Pumping and disposing of contents from all tanks and pits
- > Removing all tanks, removing covers of tanks or pits, and filling with soil, gravel, or inert solid material
- > The site shall be graded with a minimum of three inches (3") of black dirt
- > The site shall be seeded and mulched (or sodded) over the entire area that has been disturbed

Inspection Approvals Required:

- 1. From the Department of City Inspections (Room 100) at 262.653.4263:
 - > Sewer and water abandonment (prior to commencement of razing of structure)
 - Storm sewer abandonment (prior to commencement of razing of structure) unless otherwise approved by the Department of Public Works
 - Septic system/tank abandonment (prior to commencement of razing of structure)
 - > Foundation (after breaking walls down and prior to backfilling)
 - Final inspection (after grading, seeding and mulching, or sodding is completed)
- 2. From the Kenosha Water Utility at 262.653.4300:
 - Well abandonment (prior to covering)
