KENOSHA – The Wisconsin Supreme Court recently ruled that municipalities can accept absentee ballots placed in drop boxes for the Spring Primary Election on Tuesday, February 15, 2022. People may drop off their completed ballots in one of two drop boxes outside City Hall, 625 52<sup>nd</sup> St. All voted ballots must be in the City Clerk's office by 8 p.m. on election day.

In addition to the drop boxes, people also may return voted ballots to the City Clerk's office in Room 105 at City Hall; or mail it and allow enough time for it to be received in the City Clerk's office by 8 p.m. on February 15. The post office recommends mailing it seven days in advance. Ballots may also be shipped via other delivery methods (FedEx, etc). **DO NOT DROP YOUR BALLOT OFF AT A POLLING PLACE ON ELECTION DAY.**

### Requesting an absentee ballot

Those wishing to vote by mail can send or drop off a request with a copy of photo ID. Be sure to list your name, address, mailing address (if different) and signature.

- **Fax** your request to City Clerk, 262-653-4023.
- **On-line** visit [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov) to make the request that your ballot be sent to you.
- The deadline to request a ballot by mail is 5 p.m. on the Thursday before election day, UNLESS you are indefinitely confined or in the military. Then the deadline is 5 p.m. on the Friday before election day.

### Vote Early In Person

Early Voting began February 1 and will continue from through Friday, February 11 in Room 104 at City Hall, 625 52<sup>nd</sup> Street. Hours are 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. through February 10; and 8
