KENOSHA – Second District Alderperson John Fox today announced his resignation from the Common Council, citing family obligations. In a letter addressed to Kenosha Mayor John Antaramian, Fox wrote: “My commitment to my family has intensified and I do not have enough time to take care of my family and my constituents as they deserve. I have enjoyed working with you the past three years and I think the City is on strong footing with great leadership; and it will continue to progress.”

The City will begin the process to fill the vacancy after the resignation is received by the Common Council at its next meeting on Wednesday, Feb. 20.
