KENOSHA – The City’s Bulk Drop-Off site located at 1001 50<sup>th</sup> Street is open with restrictions due to the pandemic. The site will be open on Tuesdays from 9:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. or until the dumpsters are full and Saturdays from 8 a.m. – 1 p.m. or until the dumpsters are full.

Due to the site’s recent closure, the City will provide an extra day each week through June for drop off:

- Thursday, May 28<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. or until the dumpsters are full
- Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. or until the dumpsters are full
- Thursday, June 11<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. or until the dumpsters are full
- Thursday, June 18<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. or until the dumpsters are full
- Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. or until the dumpsters are full

Residents will still be required to purchase one bulk ticket for every cubic yard of debris disposed. Bulk tickets will soon be available for purchase on-line. Bulk tickets are currently available for purchase at the following locations:

Perrine's Gas & Groceries: 5145 Sheridan Road

Manny's Food & Liquor: 2121 45th Street

Mobil Gas: 4924 Sheridan Road

Please note: Bulk tickets are NOT sold at the drop-off site.

Proper identification displaying proof of residency within the City of Kenosha is required. Citizens must have their identification ready to show through the window to the site attendant. No commercial disposal is allowed.

Due to the current pandemic, there are restrictions placed on the site:

- All users of the site must have the ability to empty their own vehicles as additional assistance will not be provided. Only one visitor will be allowed to dispose of the material per vehicle.
- When requested by the site attendant, identification must be shown through the

vehicle window, which shows proof of residency within the City of Kenosha. People should place their bulk ticket in a bin under direction of the site attendant.

- People are required to remain in their vehicles until it is their turn to dispose of items at the compactor location.
- Everyone must follow the direction of the site attendant on where to drop off their material.
- Everyone must follow CDC guidelines on social distancing.
- Attendant can refuse service for any rule violation.
- Garbage must be contained in a bag, garbage can or bundled for quick service.
- All other general guidelines of the site must be followed.

First time visitors to the drop-off site are advised to visit the City web site for information on where to purchase bulk tickets, estimating cubic yardage and general guidelines of the site.
