KENOSHA- Kenosha Area Transit will operate the Lakefront Trolley Route on a modified schedule beginning Friday, May 7. Hours of operation will be 3:45 to 9:15 p.m. on Fridays; 1:45 to 9:15 p.m. Saturdays and 1:45 to 6:15 p.m. Sundays through September. Days and hours of operation are subject to change with adjustments to COVID-19 CDC protocols and standards.

The Lakefront Trolley route runs from Carthage College to Kemper Center, with stops at the Pennoyer Park bandshell, Lemon Street Gallery, the History Center, Kenosha Public Museum, Civil War Museum, the transit center and Lakeside Towers.

The trolley departs the transit center, 724 54th St., at five minutes past the hour on its southbound route and departs the transit center 30 minutes past the hour on its northbound route.
