



## Masks required on Kenosha Area Transit

KENOSHA- Kenosha Area Transit employees and riders will continue to be required to wear masks on City buses and streetcars, due to Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requirements. The mask mandate for transit agencies is based on guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control, and is now extended to September 13th, 2021. Drivers have masks available if people do not have their own mask.

TSA requirements extend to all transportation networks throughout the United States, including at airports, onboard commercial aircraft, on over-the-road buses, and on commuter bus and rail systems. TSA's initial face mask requirement went into effect on February 1. Exemptions to the face mask requirement include travelers under the age of 2 years old and those with certain disabilities. Fines for violating the requirement range from \$250 to \$1,500 for repeat offenders.
