KENOSHA – Season passes will be available for purchase beginning Tuesday, May 28, 2019 for the city's two public swimming pools at Anderson Park and Washington Park. Pools will open for the season on Saturday, June 15 at 10 a.m. – dependent on good weather.

Regular pool hours are 10 a.m. – 5:45 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday. The pools will be closed on Mondays and the Fourth of July.

Season pool passes may be purchased from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday at the Public Works Department, 625 52nd Street. There is a discount for purchasing passes before the pools open for the season. Costs for city residents are \$55 for a single pass; \$115 for a group pass of up to five and \$15 for each additional person on a group pass (maximum of three). Cost for non-residents is \$60 for a single pass; \$180 for a group pass of up to five and \$20 for each additional person on a group pass. After the pools open, costs increase by \$5 in each category for city residents. A non-resident single pool pass will cost \$75, group pass \$185 and additional person on a group pass \$25. Each person on the season pool pass is required to be present to have a photo taken for the pass.

Swim coupons good for five visits also are available for \$20. Daily pool fees are \$5 for individuals age 3 and older and \$3 for adults age 60 and older. The daily fee for non-swimming adults is \$3. Children age 2 and younger are admitted free with a paid adult (maximum of three children per adult).

Pool passes can now be purchased using credit or debit cards. A convenience fee is added when using credit or debit cards.
