KENOSHA – The Mayor’s Youth Commission has canceled this year’s Memorial Brick Dedication planned for June, due to a production problem with the brick engraving. A specific product needed to complete the engraving process is not available, as part of a wide-spread shortage impacting multiple vendors.

Each year, citizens purchase bricks to honor people who have passed away, and the bricks are installed at the Kenosha Youth Memorial at Wolfenbuttel Park. The Commission has traditionally presented a memorial program in June. This year’s ceremony was planned for June 22, but has been postponed until 2023.

All bricks purchased over the past year will be engraved and installed at the park as soon as possible. Those who have purchased the bricks will be notified so they can visit the park to see the bricks. The names from this year will be read along with those from the upcoming year’s purchases during the 2023 Brick Dedication Ceremony.

The City regrets the postponement of the Memorial Brick Dedication and appreciates everyone’s understanding and patience.
