KENOSHA – The City of Kenosha Department of Parks and Public Works will be replacing the tree planters along Sixth Avenue and 58th Street with trees planted in designated grates.

“This initiative aims to enhance the aesthetic appeal and functionality of our city's streetscaping,” said Director of Parks Katie Elder. “We kindly ask for the cooperation of all residents and visitors during this project. Your understanding and support are greatly appreciated as we work to improve our community's green infrastructure.”

The project will take place on Sixth Avenue from 55th Street to 59th Street; on Sixth Avenue A from 59th Street to Seventh Avenue; and on 58th Street from 7th Avenue to 5th Avenue.

The removal schedule for the tree planters, and parking restrictions are as follows:

- Monday, June 17th: Removal of all planters from the west side of Sixth Avenue.  
No Parking from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Tuesday, June 18th: Removal of all planters from the east side of Sixth Avenue.  
No Parking from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Thursday, June 20th: Removal of all planters along 58th Street.  
No Parking from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.
