KENOSHA – The Sister Cities Association of Kenosha will host its annual meeting from 6 to 8 p.m. Thursday, October 13 in the Lakeside Classroom at the Kenosha Public Museum, 5500 First Ave. The group will begin planning for an August 2023 visit from Kenosha's Sister City in Wolfenbuttel Germany, including the celebration of a delayed 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

Kenosha currently has Sister City relationships in Douai, France; Cosenza Italy; Quezon City, Phillipines; and Wolfenbuttel, Germany. The Sister Cities Association believes in strengthening peace and prosperity through person-to-person "citizen diplomacy." Regular exchanges and visits occur between Kenosha and Wolfenbuttel, Germany as well as Douai, France. The group's last exchange took place in 2019 to Cosenza, Italy. Visits involve both student and adult groups, who stay in the homes of host families and tour the community and surrounding areas.
