KENOSHA – Early in-person voting for the November 3 Presidential and General Election began today, October 20, and continues through October 30, 2020 at City Hall, 625 52nd Street. Voters should enter City Hall at the West entrance and will exit via the south side of the building. Parking for voters is available in the two lots on the west side of City Hall, and along 52nd Street, east of Eighth Avenue.

New this year is a drive-through voting option outside City Hall. Drivers are directed to enter Eighth Avenue from 52nd Street and travel southbound to the parking lot on the south side of City Hall. After voting, drivers will be directed to exit southbound on Eighth Avenue to 54th Street.

Dates/Times for Early in-person voting:

Tuesday, October 20 – Friday, October 23: 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Saturday, October 24: 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday, October 25: Noon to 4 p.m. Monday, October 26 – Thursday, October 29: 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Friday, October 30: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on November 3 (Election Day). Voters may register and vote at their polling place on election day. They may not register or vote at City Hall on election day.
