KENOSHA – The Kenosha Hometown Heroes Commission kicked off their nomination program on January 4, 2016. The Commission is pleased to kick off the fourth year of the program with a call for nominations for the first quarter of 2019.

The program is dedicated to identifying and recognizing as Hometown Heroes worthy men and women who have served or are currently serving in the United States Armed Forces who were born in, currently reside in, or have previously resided for ten (10) years or more at any time, in the City of Kenosha, Wisconsin. A nominator may only submit one nomination per quarter in order to maintain the integrity and importance of the awards. The Kenosha Hometown Heroes Commission will review nominations based on military service (decoration/awards, military specialty schools, length of service and tours of duty), community service (veteran organizations, volunteer work, civic organizations, and awards), and other accomplishments (coordinating reunions, going above and beyond the call of duty).

Awards will be given out on a quarterly basis. All award winners will receive a congratulatory certificate from the Mayor and will be invited to a regular meeting of the Common Council to receive their certificate and award from the Mayor and the Common Council President.

The first quarter nomination period is now open. The nomination deadline for the first quarter of 2019 is February 28, 2019.
