KENOSHA – There will be no curbside garbage, recycling, brush, tire, or bulk collection on Monday, September 3 in recognition of the Labor Day holiday. Waste collection will be delayed one day for the week of September 3. For example, Monday's route will be collected on Tuesday and Friday's route will be collected on Saturday. Regular collection schedules will resume the week of September 10. If you have brush, tires or bulk garbage that need to be collected, please call the Public Works Department at 653-4050 a minimum of one working day before your regular collection day.

The Municipal Office Building will be CLOSED Monday, September 3 in observance of the Labor Day holiday.

The Bulk Drop-Off Site, 1001 50th St., is closed on Mondays. It will re-open on Tuesday, September 4 for its normal hours of operations from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The Yardwaste Drop-Off Site, 4071-88th Avenue (HWY H), will be CLOSED Monday, September 3. It will re-open on Tuesday, September 4, 2018, for its normal hours of operations from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The Concrete/Brick Drop-off Site, 6415 35th Avenue, will be closed on Monday, September 3. It will reopen on Tuesday, September 4 for normal hours of operations from 7 a.m. – 3 p.m.
