On October 30, 2022, just after 1:00am, Kenosha Police and Fire departments responded to 4902 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue for a structure fire.

Both public safety agencies encountered an active fire with heavy smoke and flames visible. Police and Fire began evacuation efforts of the involved structure and of the neighboring buildings. Kenosha Fire Department began its fire suppression efforts and contained the fire to the second floor. The fire was extinguished within the hour.

Sadly, Antonio Davidson, a 25-year-old Kenosha resident and his 1-year old son, Amari Davidson, died from injuries related to the fire.

Kenosha Police and Fire Departments continue to actively investigate this fire with assistance from our State and Federal partners. Kenosha Police and Fire are the lead agencies conducting this investigation.

Due to the fatalities associated with this fire, both agencies proceeded forward with treating this as a criminal investigation. We will continue to do so, until all of our questions are answered.
