The Kenosha Police Department, in cooperation with the Sex Offender Registration Committee, is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statutes 301.46(2m) which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when, in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety, awareness and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense. Further, his criminal history places him in a classification level, which reflects the potential to re-offend.

This sex offender has served the sentence imposed on him by the courts, he is not wanted by the police at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear; rather, it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public.

Sex Offenders have always lived in our communities, but it was not until the passage of the registration law in 1997 that law enforcement was authorized to notify the public of a sex offender's whereabouts. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will not be

tolerated.

Alfonso Neave JR. will be released on March 20, 2023. Neave will be homeless at the time of his release and must remain in the County of Kenosha unless authorized by DOC supervision. Neave is a LIFE REGISTRANT of the sex offender registry and will be on Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) Tracking and 24-hour electronic monitoring. Neave must comply with lifetime sex offender registration requirements.

Neave is not permitted to work or volunteer with minors, nor is he allowed to be present on school grounds without permission from the local school district.
