KENOSHA – Christopher’s Project Motown Revue will kick off the 2018 Lincoln Park Live Music Series on June 27, sponsored by the Mary Lou & Arthur F. Mahone Fund and the City of Kenosha. The fourth season of free concerts takes place at 6:30 p.m. on select Wednesdays in Kenosha’s iconic Lincoln Park flower garden.

Christopher’s Project is led by Chris Pipkin on saxophone, a three-time winner of “Showtime At the Apollo.” A melting pot of musical styles, the band has opened for legendary acts such as George Benson, The Temptations and The Isley Brothers. The ensemble covers a wide variety of genres, bringing a mix of classic Motown, Top 40’s and originals.
