# Poll Worker Duties Registrar

## **Materials**



- Registration binder includes: Election Day Registration forms, acceptable proof of residence & Photo ID guidance, address lists for your polling location and other instructional materials.
- Tablet with access to <a href="MyVote.WI.gov">MyVote.WI.gov</a>, the City of Kenosha Address list, the Registered Voter list and the Ineligible Voter list.

## Responsibilities

Election Inspectors assigned to the registration table are there to assist voters who need to complete an Election Day Registration (EDR) application before casting a ballot.

It's very important for you to familiarize yourself with all your materials so that you can:

- Ensure voters have the proper proof of residency (POR)
- Verify voter is at the correct polling place/Verify the voter is NOT already registered somewhere else
- Verify voter is NOT on the Ineligible Voter List

Once the application is complete, and you have verified the POR is acceptable, you will need to complete the bottom portion of the application, and indicate the proper ward number based on their address. You will then direct them to the appropriate table, where they will turn in their application & show their ID to obtain a ballot.



This is a sample page from the address list, indicating the proper ward number. You can also refer to <a href="MyVote.WI.gov">MyVote.WI.gov</a> on the tablet if you are more comfortable with that.

# Reasons Voters Need to Register

- Turned 18 years old
- New Kenosha resident
- Changed their name and/or address
- Hasn't participated in an election from the past 4 years and their record has been deactivated

## Reasons Voter May be Directed to Register

If a seasoned voter did not stop at the greeter table and went straight to their ward table, they may be advised that their name is not in the poll book and they need to register.

- With the recent change in polling locations, they could be at the wrong place
- There might be a spelling error in their name
- Their voter record has been deactivated

Please proceed with your process of verification that the voter is indeed at the correct polling location based on their address. You can also verify their registration on <a href="MyVote.WI.gov">MyVote.WI.gov</a> by entering their name & DOB, by searching the Registered Voter List on the tablet, or in the binder provided.





# **Completing the EDR**

### Section 10 - Assistant

Due to the Disability Act, we cannot ask a voter if they have a disability or what their disability is. If a Voter has an assistant complete their application for them, and they are unable to sign their own name, the Assistant must sign the VOTER's name on the voter signature line, and then sign their own name on the assistant signature line certifying they did so on the voter's behalf.

The Election Inspector must complete the bottom portion of the application as indicated above. Please circle the Proof of Residence Type. Refer to your information sheet about acceptable documents.

Verify the correct ward number, and write it on the application for the voter. Sign & date the application, hand it back to the voter, and direct them to the proper ward table where they will be issued a voter number. (Inspectors at the poll book will enter the voter number on this form)

# REMEMBER! These are NOT acceptable forms of proof of residence:

- Doctor Bill/Statement
- Hospital Bill/Statement
- Car or Health Insurance
- Bank Checks
- Passport
- Magazine Subscription / Junk mail
- Library Card

### **Questions / Issues**

Voters who have a WI driver's license or ID number must write it on the application. If they do not have it with them, or are unable to provide the number, there are directions in your binder on how to proceed with voting provisionally. Direct them to the Chief Inspector.

Voters who are on the Ineligible Voter's list are not permitted to register or vote. This list is updated and provided to us by the Wisconsin Elections Commission. If a voter insists that they have been released from the Corrections Department, and are no longer ineligible, direct them to the Chief Inspector to call the City Clerk for further instruction. 262-653-4020

Voter completed an online application, but they were directed to visit the Clerk, and they do not have the printed application. This happens frequently as online open registration closes 28 days before the election. If they didn't bring a completed application with them, they will need to fill out the EDR with you.

Voter brought a print out of an electronically completed application with a signature already on it. Verify that it is complete in its entirety, and complete the POR certification as required.
