- Wisconsin Driver license or state ID card expiring after November 6, 2018
- U.S. passport expiring after November 6, 2018
- Military ID card expiring after November 6, 2018
- Certificate of naturalization issued within the last two years
- Unexpired Wisconsin driver license or state ID receipt
- ID card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe in Wisconsin
- Unexpired ID card issued by a Wisconsin accredited university or college – must contain issuance date, student signature, and expiration date within two years of issuance. Proof of current enrollment must accompany.

**Voters (except military, overseas and indefinitely confined) may request to have absentee ballots sent automatically for every election that is held within the same calendar year in which the request is made (Wis. Stats. 6.86 (2m)).*
