KENOSHA – The Department of City Development will be accepting proposals from eligible **not-for-profit organizations** for grants available through the 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program beginning July 12, 2021. The City of Kenosha anticipates distributing \$1,114,150 to eligible projects under the 2022 CDBG Program.

Funds will be allocated in accordance with the City of Kenosha's Community Development Fund Allocation Plan.

Project Proposals must address the City of Kenosha's 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan.

Each funded activity must meet at least one of the national objectives of the CDBG Program:

- Benefit low and moderate income persons
- Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight

ACTIVITIES MUST BE CARRIED OUT BY CITY DEPARTMENTS, OR PUBLIC OR PRIVATE NON-PROFIT AGENCIES, AUTHORITIES OR ORGANIZATIONS.

Proposals will be accepted until 10 a.m. on Friday, August 6, 2021.
