Elm	Ulmus cultivars	Vase Shaped	50' - 75'	30' - 70'	Broad parkway required; select Dutch Elm disease resistant cultivar

**DEFINITIONS:**

Conical - Appearing triangular in outline

Fastigiate – forming a column

Globose - Rounded circular form

Irregular - asymmetrical, uneven outline

Ovate - Elliptic to egg-shaped

**Please note for the Tree Planting Program:**

This is not a definitive list of approved tree. As new species appear on the market, new cultivars displace older ones. Contact the Park Division if you want a tree not on this list. Replacement parkway trees are available to residential properties whose parkway trees have been removed within the past five years.

New parkway trees must be in compliance with City ordinances – City Forestry staff will determine if the requested location qualifies for a parkway tree.

Parkway tree orders are on a first come, first serve basis until all trees are allocated for the approved funding.
