



Pool Rules and Regulations

Public Works – Park Division (rev. 11/16)

Anderson Park Pool – 8730 22nd Avenue – 262-942-3781

A tot pool with a small child slide, an Olympic-size pool with diving well, a 231 foot flume slide, a 78 foot speed slide, and an interactive splash pad.

Washington Park Pool – 1821 Washington Road – 262-653-4088

A zero depth pool with interactive features, a 200 foot water slide and a 10 foot long, 6 foot high drop slide.

The City of Kenosha Park Division has set the following policies for the safety of all patrons at the pools. These policies are subject to change at the discretion of the Park Division. Any changes will be posted at each pool.

Season Pool Pass Policies:

1. The City of Kenosha is not responsible for lost or stolen passes. Replacements are \$10 each.
2. The barcode on the passes must remain intact and not damaged.
3. Passes are non-transferable.

Swimming Pool Policies:

1. No flotation devices of any kind are allowed, even if they are a part of swim attire.
2. NO DISPOSABLE DIAPERS are allowed in the pools. Infant/Toddlers that are not toilet trained will be required to wear swim diapers. These may be purchased at the pools.
3. Swim suits are required to enter the pool. Cut-offs and personal undergarments are not allowed.
4. No climbing or hanging on spray activities, any equipment or structure.
5. Masks and goggles are allowed in the pool. NO snorkels
6. Swimmers are required to wear the appropriate wristband in the pools.
7. Admission will be refused to any person under the influence of any controlled substance or alcohol.
8. The pool will be closed for public swimming if the air temperature is 65 degrees or below, or at the discretion of the manager on duty, based on inclement weather, attendance or unusual circumstances.
9. Pool management reserves the right to close the pool if attendance falls below 15 swimmers in the pool area at any time.
10. Absolutely NO REFUNDS will be given if the pool is closed due to any circumstance.
11. The City of Kenosha reserves the right to close the pool for the season if proper guard staff cannot be maintained.

Pool Rules:

1. No diving except in designated areas.
2. No street shoes in the pool area.
3. No glass containers in the pool area.
4. No food, gum, tobacco or beverages in the pool area. Food and beverages are to be consumed in the designated concession area.
5. All persons entering the pool are required to take a cleansing shower before entering the pool and after using the restroom.
6. Do not use the pool if you have an infectious communicable disease. Be aware that open cuts, blisters or wounds may become infected.
7. No spitting, spouting water or blowing the nose in the pools.
8. Children 8 years of age and under must be supervised by an adult (age 18 and over) in the pool area.
9. Children 9 years and older must be supervised by a guardian of at least 14 years of age.
10. No running or rough play allowed in the pool or locker room areas.
11. No hanging on life lines.
12. No pets inside the pool facility.
13. No camera cell phones are permitted in the pool or locker rooms.
14. Swimmers engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior will be asked to leave the facility, with NO refund.

Water Slide Rules:

1. Users must be 42" tall and/or able to swim from the landing pool to the steps unassisted. THIS RULE SUBJECT TO CHANGE. If a user has to be assisted, he/she will not be able to use the slide.
2. First time users, please ask lifeguard for instructions.
3. Users must ride the slide feet first on their backs.
4. No watches, goggles, glasses, locker key or other sharp objects are to be worn or taken down the slide. These objects can scratch the slide and cause injury. Pool staff will not hold any belongings for swimmers.
5. Only one person will be allowed on the slide at a time. Parents may NOT hold children on the slide or catch them in the landing pool at the bottom.
6. Women who are pregnant or individuals with a heart condition or other physical impairments are advised not to use the slide.
7. Users must exit the landing pool immediately after going down the slide.
8. No running, standing, kneeling, rotating or stopping on the slide or diving from the slide.
9. Keep arms and hands inside the slide at all times.
10. Users engaging in unsafe behavior will lose pool privileges.

Anderson Park – Interactive Play Attraction – Rules:

1. Do not enter the interactive play attraction if you have a communicable disease or an open cut.
2. Do not bring food, drink, gum, tobacco, or glass into the interactive play attraction.
3. No street shoes in the pool area.
4. Do not bring animals into the interactive play attraction area.
5. Recreational, wheel-based methods of transportation are prohibited.
6. Diaper changing is permitted in designated areas only, and not allowed on splash area.
