All of Kenosha's citizens will soon have access to some of the fastest internet speeds available.

Morristown, New Jersey-based SiFi Networks has begun work on a \$100 million fiber optic network that will serve the entire City of Kenosha. The Kenosha FiberCity project is being privately funded by Sifi – the project will *not* impact property taxes in Kenosha. Users will have access to internet speeds up to 10 Gbps, among the fastest residential speeds available in the United States. The network is expected to take 3 years to complete. - there is a credit applied to the bill and the property does not qualify
