****ATTENTION****

- There is a 20 gallon limit on paint
- We DO NOT accept paint from contractors
- For safety reasons, if you are bringing batteries please put clear tape on the battery terminals.

HELP US \$AVE YOU MONEY Don't bring us your latex paint.



There is a significant cost to collect and dispose of latex paint. This cost could be avoided altogether, because it is okay to dry out latex paint and then throw it in your household garbage. Our disposal fees are based on weight. Less latex paint equals lower program costs to you.

To dry out the paint, pour a thin layer in a box lined with a plastic bag. Newspaper or

kitty litter will also help absorb more paint in the box.

When the paint in the box is dry, pour in another layer of paint. Keep repeating this process until the can is empty. You can then discard the dried paint in the garbage.

Make sure to remove the lid from the paint can before throwing it in the garbage.
